TRANSFORMATION

The 20th CBRNE Command is experimenting with concepts to reorganize the Command into three CBRNE Brigade Task Forces to better enable this Command to provide tailorable, scalable, ready, reliable and globally responsive CBRNE forces.

Aligning each of the CBRNE Brigade Task Forces with one of the Army's CONUS based Corps provides the Nation with regionally expert and integrated CBRNE capabilities to effectively prepare for and respond to CBRNE hazards in support of Combatant Commander's requirements. Enabling each CBRNE Brigade Task Force with a CBRNE Coordination Element further enhances the planning, coordination and CBRNE synchronization efforts in support of Combatant Commander and Army Service Component Commander requirements.



Transforming to multi-functional CBRNE Brigade Task Forces immediately improves the capacity and flexibility of our Army's scarce CBRN and EOD resources, by improving unity of command and unity of effort based on geographic proximity to supported forces, while ensuring the necessary technical oversight to sustain our EOD and CBRN Soldiers critical skill sets.

PROPOSED TASK ORGANIZATION

- » Does not require any MTOE changes and can be achieved without any growth in authorizations
- » Enables Unity of Command by reducing disparate command relationships across dispersed formation
- » Provides Unity of Effort and increases ability to project integrated CBRNE capability
- » Enables projection of mission command by echelon to assure proper employment and integration of CBRNE forces
- » Does not impact on-going DSCA or SOF support missions
- » Enables regional alignment consistent with HQDA and FORSCOM directives
- » Achieves and ensures necessary technical oversight requirements

MISSION AREAS

- » Defense CBRN Response Force (DCRF) - Consequence Management
- » National Technical Nuclear Forensics (NTNF) - Ground Collection Task Force
- » EOD Emergency Response to DoD and in support of Civil Authorities (DSCA)
- » Very Important Persons Protection Support Activity (VIPPSA)
- » Recovered Chemical Warfare Material (RCWM) & Chem/Bio Surety
- » Combat and Contingency Operations in Iraq/Afghanistan and CBRNE related missions world-wide
- » WMD Elimination - Serving as Joint Task Force for Elimination Headquarters, with the Capability to Mission Command Operational CBRNE Forces

CBRNE TASK FORCE

- » Provides multi-functional CBRNE capabilities organized under a designated CBRNE Company, Battalion or Brigade level Commander.
- » Provides tailorable CBRNE capability to build partner capacity, or to combat the full range of CBRNE hazards. Can be organized for functionally based threats, or task organized to defeat a broader spectrum of hazards, dependent upon COCOM and ASCC requirements.
- » Integrates CBRNE capability, tailorable to COCOM requirements with echeloned mission command capabilities, enabled through technical reachback to subject matter experts across the CBRNE Communities of Purpose.
- » The 20th CBRNE Command, in partnership with the CTCs and other members of the CBRNE community of purpose, have constructed industrial scale training venues and targets at the Combat Training Centers. These venues provide our units and supported rotational units an opportunity to encounter full-scale CBRNE hazards that include roadside IEDs, underground facilities, life-sized chemical and biological laboratories, and nuclear production/reprocessing facilities.



WHO ARE WE?

The 20th CBRNE Command is the United States Army's only formation dedicated to combating the full range of Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosive threats facing our Nation.

The Soldiers, Civilians and Contractors of the 20th CBRNE Command possess unique capabilities in a highly specialized field, making it the premier U.S. Army unit for employment against existing and emerging CBRNE threats.

All-Hazard CBRNE capability is the ability to identify, assess, render safe, dismantle, exploit, decontaminate, transfer, and dispose of Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosive hazards, including unexploded ordnance, improvised explosive devices, and weapons of mass destruction.



WHAT DO WE DO?

The 20th CBRNE Command leverages the CBRNE expertise of Army, Joint and Interagency partners across the CBRNE Community of Purpose for successful mission accomplishment of national objectives.

We partner effectively in support of Joint, Interagency, and Multi-National partners to build capacity, improve situational understanding of the operational environment and enhance integration of our forces during execution.

We are experimenting with concepts and modernizing the Command to deliver tailorable, scalable, expeditionary CBRNE capabilities.
